2012 Legislative Session Changes

The following modifications were incorporated in the file 2012-1 State Statutes (not published) in support bills enacted during the 2012 Colorado State Legislature and first extraordinary session:

- Changed 14-4-1601 H&R w/ SBI changed from **5 F** to **4 F** (HB 12-1084)
- Added to 18-8-111 False Reporting a 2 M if the “alarm” was tripped in the commission of another crime (HB 12-1304)
- Criminal Libel statute (18-13-105) was repealed (SB 12-102).
- Added Unlawful possession of cathinones (bath salts), 1 M (HB 12-1310)
- Added Unlawful distribution, manufacturing, dispensing, or sale of cathinones (bath salts) 3 F (HB 12-1310)
